

Prof. Baris Akinci is a key global opinion leader in the diagnosis & management of lipodystrophy. Dr. Akinci received his M.D. degree from Ege University. He completed his residency in internal medicine and his clinical fellowship in endocrinology in Turkey. Dr. Akinci is a full-time professor at Dokuz Eylul University (currently on leave). He worked with Dr. Abhimanyu Garg at UT Southwestern. Since 2018, he has been working with Dr. Elif Oral at the University of Michigan. Dr. Akinci is the founder of the Turkish Lipodystrophy Study Group. His research focuses on the natural history of lipodystrophy, and the link to metabolic abnormalities and end-organ complications. Dr. Akinci is a board member of the European Consortium on Lipodystrophies (ECLip) and has more than 100 published articles about endocrine disorders, diabetes, lipodystrophy syndromes, and leptin.
