Josivan Lima holds a degree in Medicine (1995) and a doctorate in Health Sciences (2016) from the Federal University of Rio Grande do Norte. He has specialized in Endocrinology at Agamenon Magalhães Hospital in Recife/PE, Brazil (1996-1997) and City Hospital, Nottingham/UK (1998).

He was general secretary of the Brazilian Society of Endocrinology from 2009 to 2012. Dr. Lima is a professor of endocrinology at the Onofre Lopes University Hospital (Natal, Brazil) since 2004, and published 30 articles in international journals, mainly in the area of diabetes, dyslipidemia and metabolic syndrome.

His work focuses on lipodystrophy, and he has followed more than 40 patients.
